Item 8.01 Other Events

On January 31, 2024, NextEra Energy Capital Holdings, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of NextEra Energy, Inc. (NEE), sold \$1 billion principal amount of its 4.95% Debentures, Series due January 29, 2026, \$900 million principal amount of its 4.90% Debentures, Series due March 15, 2029, \$1.1 billion principal amount of its 5.25% Debentures, Series due March 15, 2034, \$800 million principal amount of its 5.55% Debentures, Series due March 15, 2054 (Fixed Rate Debentures) and \$600 million of its Floating Rate Debentures, Series due January 29, 2026 (Floating Rate Debentures, and together with the Fixed Rate Debentures, Debentures), all of which are guaranteed by NEE. The Floating Rate Debentures will bear interest at a rate equal to Compounded SOFR (a compounded Secured Overnight Financing Rate as specified in the Floating Rate Debentures) plus 0.76%. The Debentures were registered under the Securities Act of 1933 pursuant to Registration Statement Nos. 333-254632, 333-254632-01 and 333-254632-02. This Current Report on Form 8-K is being filed to report as exhibits certain documents in connection with the sale of the Debentures.
